





GINGERBREAD ORNAMENT

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Clear Plastic 3-in. Round Flat Ornament #30121828
- Brown Acrylic Paint Medium to light shade (Delta Ceramcoat Golden Brown #77625012)
- White Acrylic Paint #77624882
- Clear Satin Varnish # 30119193
- Artist Sponge #77514083
- Fine tip brush for detailing if using paints
- Paint markers for detailing black, red, white, etc.
- Or Acrylic Paints red, black, etc.

NOTE: Prep your ornament by wiping it down with rubbing alcohol to remove any oils that may have been left from your hands.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Remove the top ornament hanger crown and set it aside.

TIP: You can place the ornament onto a chopstick or dowel or clip a clothespin to paint.

Dip your artist sponge into the brown paint and dab the outside of the clear ornament. Sponge painting gives the surface a little more texture and is also an easy way to paint onto surfaces like plastic and glass.



5. Sponge a clear coat of the satin varnish over the painted ornament.

Let dry.



2. Use paint markers or acrylic paint to add the details to the face like the eyes, mouth and cheeks.



6. Place the hanger crown back onto the ornament.

TIP: You can add some cinnamon and/ or nutmeg inside of the ornament before recapping for a fun scent.

You can embellish the ornament a little more by cutting up some picks and gluing some pieces along the top.

Tie a bow around the top of the ornament.



3. Use the white acrylic paint or a paint marker to draw the icing on the gingerbread person.

You can draw a squiggly line across the forehead. Or, draw a squiggly line around the whole face. Many ways to add the icing details.

Let dry.



4. You can also add a name or sentiment with the year on the back of the ornament.

Let dry.
