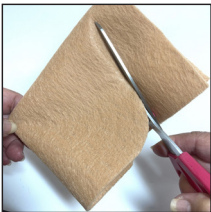
REINDEER JAR

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Mason Jar or Clear Glass Jar #30215552
- 1-2 qty. 9-in x 12-in Felt - Cashmere Tan #77676767
- Fiberfill
- 2 qty. Moving eyes - 25mm #30055161
- 4 qty. Chenille Stems - Brown #77674085
- Doll Needle or similar
- Crochet Thread - White #77524587
- 1-in. Pom Pom or similar for the nose
- Ribbon for bow
- Optional - Christmas Picks for embellishing
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun and glue sticks



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Fold one of the Cashmere Tan felt pieces into a quarter fold.

Cut the open edges into a curve, creating one large felt circle.



5. Cut out two leaf shapes from the cashmere tan felt for the ears.

Glue to the top of the head on either side.



2. Thread the large needle with crochet thread, double thickness and knot the ends.

About 1/4-in. from the edge, sew a running stitch around the felt circle.



6. Take two brown chenille stems and twist into a branch shape to make an antler. Repeat with other two chenille stems.

Glue an antler by each ear.



3. Pull the ends of the crochet thread to create a drawstring bag. Stuff the drawstring felt bag with fiberfill.

Pull the ends of the crochet thread tight and knot to secure. Add more fiberfill if needed.

Cut out a small circle from the cashmere tan felt and glue over the opening to hide the fiberfill.



7. Tie a bow around the jar lid.

Fill jar with treats and use as a gift or centerpiece.

Add a tag to the ribbon if you want with "to:/from: "or a message like "For a Deer Friend"



4. Glue the stuffed felt piece to the top of the jar lid.

Glue on moving eyes and a pom pom nose to create the face.

Add heart cheeks if you want.
