





MINI UGLY SWEATER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 qty. 3.5 in. x 5 in felt sweater color
- Pen/pencil for tracing
- Scratch paper for designing
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Tacky Glue #1360916
- Finishing Pin Back, Magnet or ribbon/cording for a hanger

Assorted Decorations -

Felt, Pom poms, glitter, mini garland, mini ornaments, jingle bells, sequins, buttons, embroidery floss, yarn, beads, ribbon, paints, etc.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. On a 3.5 in. \times 5 in. piece of scratch paper, draw a sweater shape or use the pattern provided. Cut out and use as your sweater template.



5. Place the decorated sweater on the second sweater, aligning the edges.

If you are making an ornament or garland, add in a looped ribbon/cord in between the layers for the hanger. Carefully glue the sweater pieces together around the edges. You can also sew them together if you prefer.



2. Place the sweater template on the two pieces of felt. Trace and cut out.



6. To make a pin -

Add a pinback behind the sweater to make it wearable.

You can add several sweater pins to a blinking light necklace for a festive design!



3. Take one of the sweater pieces and decorate using all kinds of craft items.

You can trace and cut out shapes from felt. For example, these circles will be for a snowman.



7. Pin a sweater onto a card front or tag.

You can add a funny message like "Try and have a Merry Christmas, even though your sweater looks ridiculous" or "Your sweater looks quite frightful but hoping your Holidays are still delightful"



4. Glue on sequins and shaker card fillers to add sparkle.

You can also make designs with the tacky glue and sprinkle on glitter.

Use acrylic paint to add details like the snowman's eyes, mouth and arms.

Let glue or paints dry.



8. You can string several sweaters together to make a fun garland or you can just hang them on the tree as ornaments.
