



REINDEER CARD HOLDER

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 2 qty. - 9 in. x 12 in. Felt – Cashmere Tan #77676767 for reindeer
- 2 qty. - 9 in. x 12 in. Felt – Antique White #77677559 for antlers
- 2 qty. - 2 in. x 2 in. Felt – White #77676635 for eyes
- 2 qty. - 2 in. x 2 in. Felt – Black #77676643 for eyes
- 2 qty. - 2 in. x 2 in. Felt – Red #77676619 for heart cheeks
- Small Red ornament ball, jingle bell or similar for reindeer nose
- 2 qty. - 12 in. Chenille Stems – light color for inside the antlers
- 4 inches of 1/4 in. ribbon for hanger
- 2 yds. of 7/8 in. or wider ribbon for card hanger and bow
- Pen/Pencil for tracing
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue Sticks
- Small wood clothespins or clips for hanging cards on ribbon
- Optional - Fiberfill for stuffing, Christmas picks, jingle bells for added embellishment



NOTE: In place of making the eyes from felt, you can use 40mm Moving eyes.

INSTRUCTIONS



1. Quarter-fold one of the tan felts pieces and place the pattern on top, aligning the sides on the fold as the pattern indicates. Trace pattern and cut out.

Place the cut out felt on the other tan felt and use as a pattern. Trace and cut out.



5. Place the other tan circle on top, matching the edges. Glue the two pieces together.

OPTIONAL - you can add a little fiberfill in between if you want it more dimensional.



2. Fold the 1/4 in. ribbon in half to form a loop. Glue to the top of one tan circle for the hanger.

Cut the wider ribbon in half and glue to the opposite edge of the tan circle for the card holder.



6. Trace and cut out eye patterns from white and black felt. Place a black circle on the white and glue.

For the nose, remove the top of the small red ornament ball. Place the eyes and red ornament ball on top of the tan felt circle to make the face and glue in place.

Cut a heart from each of the red felt pieces and place just under the eyes for the cheeks. Glue in place.



3. Take one of the Antique White Felt pieces and fold in half. Use the pictured sample as reference and cut out a branch-like piece for the antler, cutting through both thicknesses of the felt. Keep the pieces together. Repeat with the other Antique White felt piece.



7. Use the leftover Tan felt and cut two pieces about 2 in. x 3 in.

Take one piece and fold in half lengthwise. Cut out a half leaf shape for the ears. Use this as the pattern for the second felt piece.

Put a short line of glue in the middle at one end and pinch together.

Glue to the base of the antlers for the ears.



4. Lift the top piece on each set of antlers. Place a chenille stem down the center and glue in place. This will make the antler shapeable and stand up. Glue the two matching antler pieces together, with the chenille stem in between. Place an antler on either side of the top ribbon loop and glue in place.



8. Use the rest of the ribbon to make a loopy bow. Glue on the front at the bottom of the reindeer face. Add Christmas floral picks or jingle bells if you want. Hang the reindeer up using the ribbon loop at the top as the hanger. Use the small clothespins to clip Christmas cards to the ribbon to display.
