



# SNOWMAN TREAT JAR

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Crimp Top Ivy Bowl
- Multi-Surface Satin Acrylic Paint - white
- Sponge for painting
- 2 - 25mm Moving Eyes
- 1" x 2" Foamie - Orange for the nose
- 3" x 3" Foamie - Black for the mouth
- 9" x 12" Felt, any color, for beanie
- 12" of thin ribbon or baker's twine for beanie
- Scissors
- Low temp Glue Gun & Glue sticks
- OR Glue Dots and Tacky glue



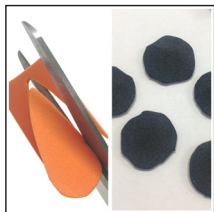
## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Make sure the crimp top ivy bowl is clean and dry before painting. Use the sponge to dab the white paint all over the outside of the ivy bowl. Let dry.



5. Line the two pieces up, overlapping 1/2" on two 6" edges and glue together to make one long piece.



2. Take the orange foamie and cut out a long triangular teardrop shape, like a carrot, for the snowman's nose.

Take the black foamie and hand cut five 1/2" round shapes for "pieces of coal" for the mouth.



6. Cut off about 4" from one end. Overlap the edges and glue together to make a tube. Place the tube over the top of the ivy bowl. Take the 12" of baker's twine and wrap around the top, cinching to gather the top.



3. After the paint is dry, glue the two eyes to the ivy bowl. Glue the nose below the eyes. Glue the five round black foamies into a smile shape below the nose for the mouth.



7. Cut the top of the cinched felt, making small snips to create a fringe for the beanie top.



4. To make the beanie, take the 9" x 12" felt and cut in half to create two 9" x 6" pieces.



8. Roll up the bottom edge of the beanie a couple of times. Fill ivy bowl with goodies and place beanie on top as a cover.
