CRAFT STICK SNOWMAN

SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- Jumbo Craft Stick*
- White Acrylic Paint
- 1 1/2" x 1 1/2" Black Foamie- hat
- 1" x 1" Orange Cardstock - nose
- 2 - 7mm Moving eyes
- Black Fine Tip Sharpie Marker
- 6" of 1/4" Red Satin Ribbon - scarf
- 5" of Baker's Twine or similar for hanger
- Mini Glue Dots
- 1/4" Double Stick Tape
- Low Temp Glue Gun & Glue sticks
- Optional: 1/2" Heart shape punch

NOTE: The sizes are based on using a Jumbo craft stick. But you can use any size craft stick, including the minis, and just scale the other pieces down. You can also use markers or acrylic paint for the eyes and nose.



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Paint the craft stick, including the edges, with the white acrylic paint. Let dry.

Tie the ends of the baker's twine together to form the hanger. Glue to the end of one side of the painted stick, this will end will be the top of the snowman.



2. Take the black foamie and cut into a top hat as shown.

Glue to the top of the craft stick, sandwiching the baker's twine in between.



3. Glue the eyes below the hat.

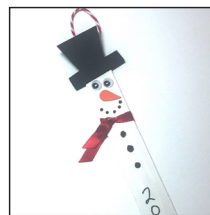
For the carrot nose, you can punch out a 1/2" heart from the orange cardstock and cut in half. Or, just free hand cut a tiny carrot nose. Glue under the eyes.



4. Use the black fine tip marker to draw circles under the nose for the mouth.



5. Take the red satin ribbon and tie around the stick below the face for a scarf. Use a dot of glue to secure.



6. Use the fine tip black marker to draw in 3 buttons on the body below the scarf. You can also add the year or a name to personalize.



7. Hang the snowman up as an ornament or stick a bunch in a pot for a tabletop decoration.
