# FOLD OVER GIFT CARD HOLDER

## SUPPLIES & TOOLS

- 4.25 in. x 11 in Cardstock – card base
- 4 in. x 4 in. Printed Cardstock
- 2.25 in. x 4 in. cardstock for gift card pocket
- 3.5 in. x 3.5 in. cardstock for circle base – print or solid
- Embellishment for circle – stickers, stamping, etc.
- Button or cardstock circle for closure
- Foam Pop Glue dots #30103261
- Double stick tape #30013283
- We R Score Board #30195075
- Circle Punch or Circle die cut and die cutting machine\*
- Scissors

NOTE: You can also use a circular shape to trace and cut out by hand in place of a punch or die.



## INSTRUCTIONS



1. Place the 4.25 in. x 11 in. cardstock onto the score board with the 11-inch edge along the top. Score at 2.5 in. and 6.75 in.



2. Fold over the 2.5 in. section. About half an inch from the right edge, punch or die cut out half a 2.5 in. circle.



3. Fold at the 6.75 in. scored line to the back and tape panel down.



4. Center the 2.25 in. x 4 in. cardstock pocket along the bottom edge of the 4 in. square. Tape the pocket in place by taping just two sides and bottom. Lift the 2.5 in. flap and center the 4 in. square on the bottom layer. Tape down.



5. Decorate the 2.5 in. circle. Close the top flap and place the circle inside the half circle cut out. Tape in place to the panel below.



6. With the flap closed, position a button or other closure piece just below the flap edge on the left side, use a pop dot to glue down. The flap will tuck behind this piece to keep the card closed.



7. Add more embellishments to the card and write a message on the inside of the flap if you want.

Open flap to place gift card inside of the pocket.
