

# Panda Snack pack

## Supplies:

- 1 qty. 2" x 9 3/4" Clear Crystal Pack bag #30126248
- 1 qty. 3" x 3" White Cardstock – panda
- 1 qty. 2" x 2" Black Cardstock – ears
- 1 qty. 1" x 2" Black cardstock – eyes and nose
- 1 qty. 2" x 4" Cardstock – any color for grad cap
- 2 qty. 3 1/2" x 3 1/2" Cardstock – solid or printed for backing
- 1 qty. Medium brad – color coordinate for grad cap
- Embroidery floss or crochet thread – colors for tassel
- Black Sharpie marker #91029 or similar
- 3/16" Meriken Double-Stick Tape #30013283
- Sakura QuicKie Glue Pen #30051737
- Foam Pop Dot #30008288
- Clear tape or stapler for sealing bag
- 3-4 snack size candy bars or similar treats

## Tools:

- Clever Lever Punches –
  - 2" Circle (Blue) #30028738
  - 2 1/2" Scallop Circle (Pink) #30028755
  - 1" Circle (Green) #30028719
  - 5/8" Oval (Orange) #30028696
- 5/16" Circle Punch – EK Success #30100069
- 1/4" Hole Punch – Fiskars #77178558
- 1/8" Hole Punch – Fiskars #77178541
- Sharp Scissors
- Pencil for tracing

## Instructions:

Take the white cardstock and punch out one 2" circle. From the leftover white, punch out two 1/4" circles. Take the black 1" x 2" cardstock and punch out two 5/8" ovals and one 5/16" circle.

Referring to the pictured sample, place the two black ovals onto the white 2" circle for the eyes, almost in the middle. Slant the ovals a little and glue down. Place the white 1/4" circles on top and glue down. Use the black marker to color in the eyes onto the white. Place the 5/16" black circle below the eyes for the nose and glue in place.

Trace and cut out the patterns for the grad cap from the solid colored cardstock. Align the rounded end of the top of the cap along the top of the panda's head. Glue in place. Take three 4" strands of the embroidery floss and braid together. Adjust the length of the tassel if necessary and knot both ends, it's just easier to braid a longer length. At the end of one knot, trim and separate the floss. Place the brad through the top of the other knotted end. Use the 1/8" hole punch to make a hole in the center of the top of the cardstock grad cap. Place the braid in with the floss attached for the tassel. Attach the top of the grad cap to the bottom with a foam pop dot.

Punch two 1" circle from the remaining black cardstock. Place behind the head on either side of the grad cap for the ears. Glue in place.

Fill the clear bag with snack size candy bars or other treats. Tape or staple the top closed. Punch out two 2 1/2" scallop circles from printed or solid cardstock. Stamp or write a message near the edge if desired.

Sandwich the top of the treat bag between the two scallop circles and tape in place. Add the panda to the scallop circle with foam pop dots.

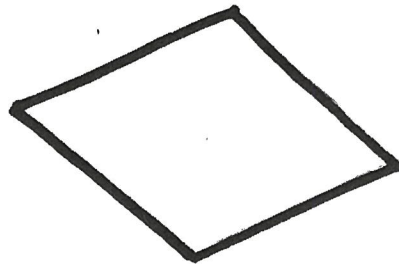
