Felt Sakura Pin/Magnet

Creative Idea by Joy S.

Supplies:

- 2 qty. 3.5" x 3.5" Shocking Pink felt #30147521 or Baby Pink #77676718
- DMC Embroidery Floss - coordinating color
- Pin Back or magnet*
- *glue for magnet



***PATTERN ON BACK**

NOTE: Basic Embroidery knowledge is helpful.

Tools:

- Sharp Scissors
- Pencil/Pen for tracing
- Embroidery needle #77650374
- Low temp Glue gun & Glue sticks

Instructions:

Trace and cut out pieces from felt according to the pattern.

Take the 6-strand embroidery floss and separate into 2 pieces of three strands each. You will work with only three strands on your needle.

Stamens:

Take just one felt flower and use the pattern as a guide to embroider the stitches. The balls at the end are French knots. **OPTION:** You do not have to embroider the stamens; you can use markers or fabric paint instead.

Finishing:

Place the two flower pieces together. Join together by using a blanket stitch around the edges. **OPTION:** You can also just glue the two pieces together.

Glue the pin back or magnet behind.



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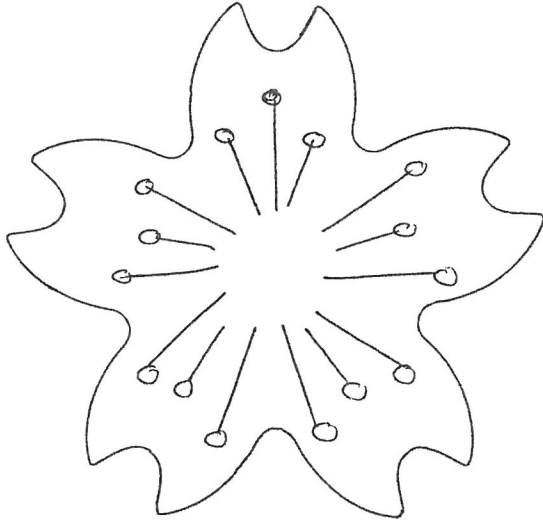
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Sakura Pattern
