Supplies:

30029805 12x12-in. White Scrapbook Frame 30137612 12x12-in. Burlap Fabric Sheet 30154352 Chalky Finish Vintage Paint (Americana Décor) 8oz

77536417 Mini Glue Gun - Low temp 30118061 Glass Gems 30141426 Alcohol Ink (.5oz ET Stream) 30155160 Starfish 2-ct. 30150432 Netting 77659581 DecoColor Pen - Brd White Seashells

Sandwich Bag Paint brush Optional: rubbing alcohol



Directions:

Take desired amount of glass gems and place in sandwich bag. Add a couple of drops of alcohol ink. If the color is too light add a few more drops; if color is too dark add a few drops of rubbing alcohol. Once you have achieved your perfect color then place glass gems on a paper towel to dry.

Using the Chalky Finish Vintage paint, brush over burlap lightly, just enough to give the burlap some color. Set aside to dry.

Open the 12x12-in. frame and remove advertisement paper from frame, hot glue painted burlap to inside of frame backing to secure. Arrange netting, glass gems, starfish and shells on burlap and then hot glue in place.

Assemble frame back together.

Write a saying on the front of the glass with DecoColor pen.
