FISHY FISHY

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- Tissue paper assorted colors #30070135
- Cardstock 12x12 black #30152451
- Cardstock 12x12 snowbird #30169261
- Dowel rods 3/16inx12in #77187534
- Elmer's clear glue 5oz #30188619
- Bakery twine #30162500
- Double stick tape 3/16in #30013283
- Punch circle .5in #30028718
- Punch circle .25in #30136620
- Scissors #30175748
- Trimmer surecut 12in #30088131
- Hand punch-circle 1/8in #77178541



INSTRUCTIONS

1) Cut white cardstock to 6" x 2.5". Form a tube and use the double-stick tape to hold the paper in place.

2) Cut tissue paper (in multiple layers) to 1" strip, cut scalloped edge. Glue scalloped edged tissue paper strip to the paper tube, start from the bottom and work your way up.

3) Cut tissue paper (in multiple layers) to 1/4" x 3" strips. Glue the tissue strips to the in-side bottom of the tube. Lightly scrunch the paper strips at the bottom.

4) Use 1/8" paper punch to punch two holes at the top of the fish about 1/4" down from the edge.

5) Insert the string through the holes and tie to the wood dowels.

6) To make eyes: Cut out 2 white round circle 3/4" size, 2 black round circle 1/2" size. Glue the black circle on top of the white circle. Glue eyes to fish.

7) Repeat and make 2 more.
