EZ POLY TUBING FISH FAVOR

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- 9" of Poly tubing – 3" wide (blue #30012297, red #30012295)
- 2 pcs. of 6" length Curling ribbon
- 2" x 2" White Cardstock - for the eyes
- Black Sharpie marker #91029
- White Sharpie or Deco Color marker – for eye highlight
- Glue Dot #30001508 or double-stick tape #30013284
- Scissors
- 3/4" or 1" Circle Punch #30028718, #30028719
- Wrapped Treats



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Take the 9" of poly tubing and gather up one open end, about 1/2" in from the edge. Use one of the curling ribbons to securely tie up with a double knot. Trim off the excess ribbon.



2. Turn the tubing inside out so the gathered end is on the inside. Fill with wrapped treats, leaving about 3" on the open end.

Use the other curling ribbon to securely tie the end closed. Double knot and curl the ends of the ribbon.



3. Use the scissors to cut a wavy edge along the end of the tubing. Cut the side edges of the tubing apart, stopping about 1/2" away from the knot.

Spread apart the two layers of tubing to shape the fish tail.



4. Use the circle punch to cut two circles from the white cardstock for the eyes. Use the black marker to draw in the eyes. Add a small white dot on the black for highlights.

Use glue dots or double stick tape to add eyes to both sides of the fish.
