



GRADUATE TREAT BAG/BOX

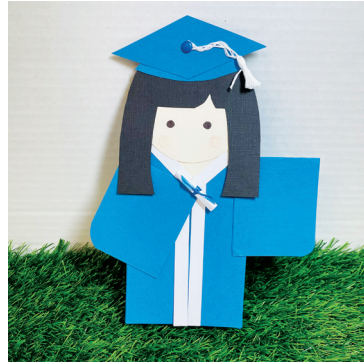
Graduate version of Kimono Girl Treat Bag/Box



MATERIALS & TOOLS

To make the Graduate version of the Treat Bag (without Pocky Box base) you will need the **supplies and tools from the Original Kimono Girl treat Bag/Box project sheet with these exceptions:**

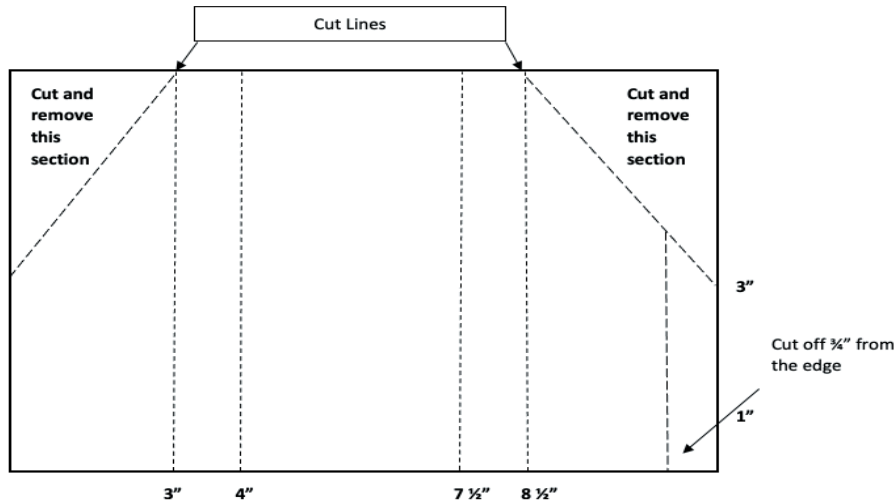
- Graduation Gown (Kimono) cardstock piece is 7 3/8" x 11"
- Cream/beige cardstock for the Neckline is 3 1/2" x 3 1/2"
- 4 qty. 3/8" x 6" cardstock for the collar neckline and front of gown accents
- Glittered Tag - Graduation Cap die cut OR
- 4" x 4" Cardstock for the Grad cap
- Metal Brad and ready-made tassel or embroidery floss for tassel



NOTE: You do not need the 11/2" x 11" cardstock for the obi

INSTRUCTIONS

1) Follow the original Kimono Girl Treat Bag /Box instructions through step 23. Then measure and cut off 3/4" from the right edge.



With the Kimono 7 3/8" x 11" cardstock, going right to left, score at 3", 4" 7 1/2" and 8 1/2". Score 1" above the bottom edge.

INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)

2) Follow step 24 which is to crease all scored lines. To create the bag, overlap the 1 3/4" right side onto the left side. Tape down to secure.

3) Follow step 25 - Place the 3/8" strip along the angled edges to create the neckline trim. Cut off excess at the top and bottom of the trim. For the graduation gown, place the remaining two 3/8" strips down the center front of the gown. Tape in place and cut off the excess.

4) Follow steps 26 - 29 to complete the girl.

5) Graduate Finishing Touches -

Use the pre-made glittered grad cap die cut and glue to the top of the head. Or, make your own by tracing the pattern out of cardstock. Tape the half circle piece to the top of the head. Make a tassel from embroidery floss and attach to the top of the grad cap piece with a brad. Tape to the top of the grad cap to complete.
