



BASIC PAPER FAN

MATERIALS & TOOLS

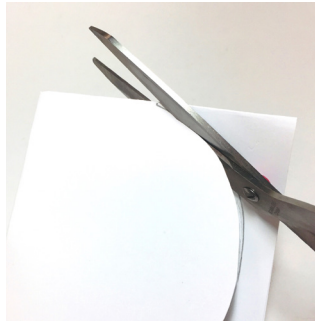
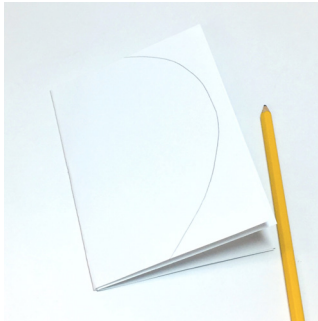
- 8.5 x 11 Cardstock
- Jumbo Craft Stick #77676437 or wood chopstick
- Pencil
- Scissors
- Low Temp Glue Gun

• Decorate your fan with more cardstock, rubberstamps, markers, washi tape, stickers, etc.

NOTE: Choose a printed cardstock or print out a design on your computer. If you're creating a computer design, center the design for just half of the 8.5 x 11 sheet and start at least an inch below the midpoint. Test print out design and match against template and adjust placement.



INSTRUCTIONS



1) Create a template for your fan. Fold the cardstock in half. Then one more time so it is quartered. Draw a curved design starting from the top folded edge about 2 inches away from the center fold.

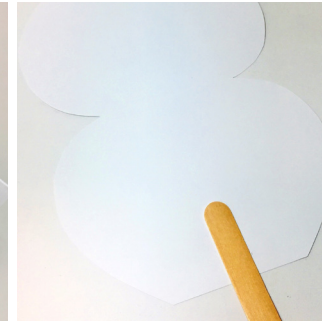
2) Cut along the curved edge through all thicknesses and open up to reveal fan shape template. Set the template aside.

3) Fold the cardstock for the fan in half. Place template on cardstock and trace lightly around the side edges.

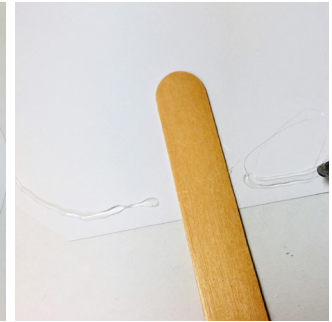
INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)



4) Cut just inside of the pencil line, but be careful not to cut the fold apart.



5) Open up the cardstock. Put a line of glue in the center, starting about a third from the bottom. Place the jumbo craft stick or chopstick on the glue line for the fan handle.



6) On the same half of the fan, place a line of glue around the curved side edges and bottom. If you are using a low temp glue gun, you'll need to work fast.



7) Fold over the other side of the fan, gluing the two sides together. Now your fan is ready to use!
