COLLAGE BASKET/BOWL

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- Bowl Shape for modeling form
- Plastic Cling Wrap to cover bowl
- Mod Podge - Glossy #77501684
- Tissue paper - assorted colors
- Medium Paint brush
- Scissors
- **Optional** - Clear varnish



INSTRUCTIONS



1. Cover the outside of the bowl with the plastic cling wrap, smoothing out as best as you can. Fold the ends of the wrap over to the inside of the bowl. Turn the bowl upside down so the bottom is facing up.



2. Cut or tear the tissue paper into small pieces.



3. Working on a small section at a time, spread a thin layer of the Mod Podge onto the clear wrapped bowl.

INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)



4. Place the pieces of tissue onto the Mod Podge, overlapping the ends and brushing on more Mod Podge. Cover the outside of the whole bowl.



5. Carefully remove the dried tissue bowl by releasing the plastic wrap from the base bowl. Carefully remove the plastic wrap from inside the bowl.



6. Trim the top edge of the bowl as needed.

Optional: Coat with a layer of clear varnish.

Use the bowl for lightweight items.

Add another layer of tissue to make the bowl sturdy. Brush on another coat of Mod Podge all over the bowl to seal.

Let dry completely, usually overnight.
