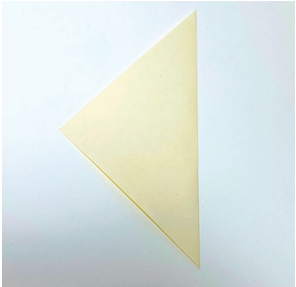
MATERIALS & TOOLS

- 2 sheets of Square paper, same size
- 1/4" Double Stick Tape #30013284
- **Optional** - Paper Creaser #30003774

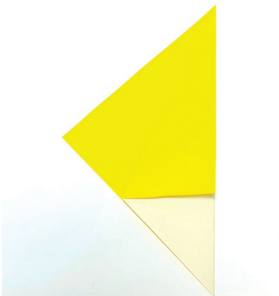
NOTE: Samples shown used 3" x 3" paper.



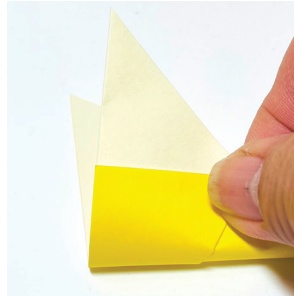
INSTRUCTIONS



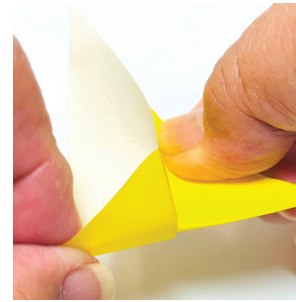
1. Take one square paper and place in front of you on point (like a diamond) with the right side of the paper facing up. Take the right-side point and fold over to the left point, resulting in a triangle. Crease well.



2. Take just the top layer and fold back towards the right, aligning with the folded edge. Crease well.

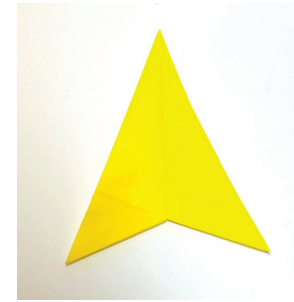


3. Flip the piece over. Slowly bring the bottom point up to meet the top point. Do not crease yet.

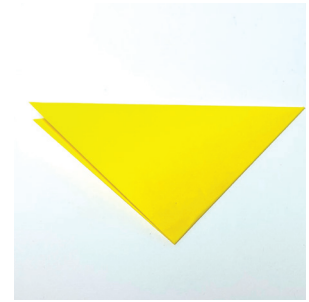


4. Hold the diagonal edges together, pinched together between two fingers.

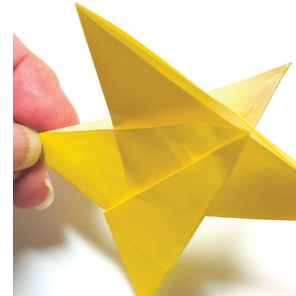
Slowly, pull the small flap on top towards you, aligning the right diagonal edge with the left straight edge.



5. Squash fold. Crease well. Set this piece aside for now.



6. Take the second square paper, right side facing down, place on point and fold in half, creating a triangle. Crease well. Fold in half again to make a smaller triangle. Crease well.



7. Slip the second triangle between the first piece, creating a 5-point star.



8. Place a piece of double stick tape in between the layers to keep the star shape intact.

Finished star.



9. Use the star as a decoration for posters, cards, etc.

String them together for a banner.

Make a lei - slip a quarter in the center fold and use a glue dot to hold it in place. Slide the stars into the 3" poly tubing and tie ribbon in between.
