# GRANDPARENT'S DAY CARD

## INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)

### MATERIALS & TOOLS

- 5.5" x 8.5" Card base - solid or printed cardstock
- 4" x 4" Brown Cardstock for bears' heads
- 2" x 4" Brown Cardstock for the bears' ears
- 2" x 2" Light brown Cardstock for the bears' muzzle
- 3" x 3" Pink Cardstock for the heart
- Sharpie Fine Pt. Black Marker #91029
- Meriken 1/4" Double stick tape #30013284
- Scissors
- Dime and 2 oz. paint bottle for tracing template or 1 1/2" #30028731 and 1/2" #30028691 Circle punches



### INSTRUCTIONS



1) Cut out four bear heads and eight ears from brown cardstock. Cut out four muzzles the same size as the ears from a lighter brown cardstock. You can use paper punches or use a dime and bottom of a paint bottle for tracing.

2) Assemble the bears' heads - Add two ears by taping two of the smaller brown circles to the back of the head. Tape the lighter brown circle to the lower half of the head. Use a marker to draw in the nose and mouth on to muzzle. Draw in two eyes above the muzzle. Repeat to make three more bears' heads

3) Fold the card base in half to create a 4.25" x 5.5" card. Tape two bear heads onto the front. Write the first part of the message directly onto the card or on a separate cardstock piece taped to the front. Write in "Side by side"

4. Inside of the card, tape the remaining two bears on either side so they are apart. Cut out a heart from the pink cardstock and tape to the inside, as shown. Use the marker to finish the message:

"or far apart  
 Grandpa and Grandma  
 You are always in our hearts"
