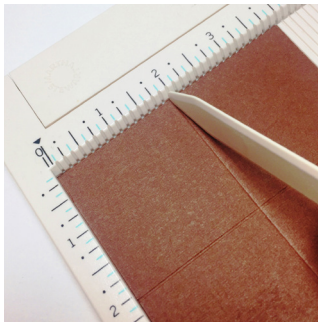
**MATERIALS & TOOLS**

- 4" x 4" Cardstock - Reddish Brown fox color
- 2" x 2" Light Tan colored cardstock
- 2 qty. Black Rhinestone stickers or moving eyes
- 1 qty. Black Rhinestone stickers or cardstock, foamie
- 1/4" Meriken Double Stick tape #30013284
- Paper Trimmer #30088131
- Scissors
- Scoring Board
- 1/4" Hole Punch #77178558

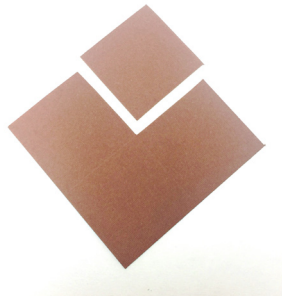
**NOTE:** You can use other sizes for the eyes and nose as you like.



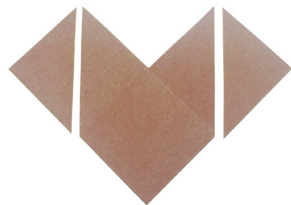
**INSTRUCTIONS**



1) Take the 4" x 4" cardstock and score at 2". Then turn and score at 2" again so that there's four equal squares

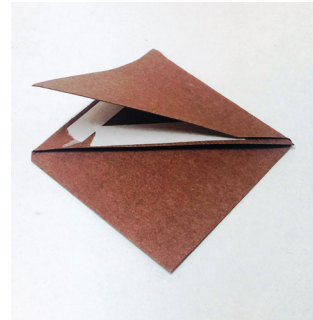


2) Cut one square out.



3) Use the scissors to cut the outer squares diagonally across leaving you with two triangles. Save these triangles for later.

**INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)**



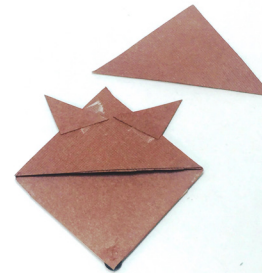
4) Fold the side triangles in, overlapping. Tape the overlap together. Turn the piece over. This is the bookmark base.



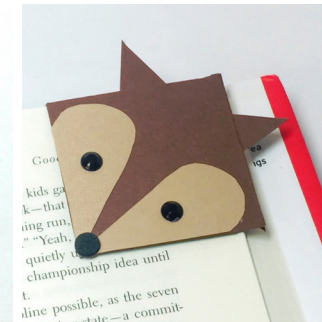
5) Take the 2" x 2" light tan colored cardstock and fold in half. Cut out an elongated heart. Cut the heart in half.



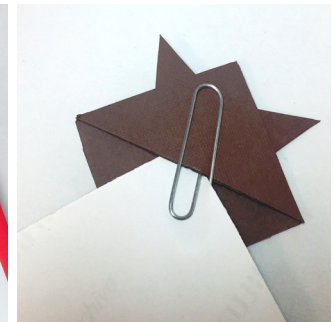
6) Match the straight edge of the hearts to the outer edges. Tape pieces down for the fox's face. Add the eyes. For the nose you can use the 1/4" hole punch with black foamie. You can also just draw in the eyes and nose with a marker.



7) For the ears, take one of the scrap triangles and cut two tips off. Place one behind on either side and tape in place. For a nice finish, tape the remaining triangle on top to hide the back of the ears.



8) Use as a bookmark by placing over the corner of the book's page.



9) You can also slip a paperclip to the back then add a magnet and use as a photo/notepad holder.

**SAMPLE**
