



BOY'S DAY FISH FAVOR

MATERIALS & TOOLS

- Clean, empty toilet paper roll
- 4 1/2" x 6" Cardstock* - your color of choice
- 2" x 2" White Cardstock for eyes
- Black Sharpie marker #91029
- Assorted paper scraps for fish scales and tail
- Crayons or markers for coloring
- 12" of Crochet Thread for hanger
- Meriken 1/4" Double Stick tape #30013284
- Scissors
- Paper trimmer #30088131
- Needle or similar
- Dime or 1/2" circle punch #30136620
- Pencil for tracing
- Stapler

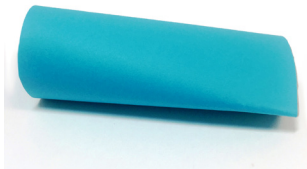
*NOTE: Adjust the size of the cardstock as needed to fit the empty roll.



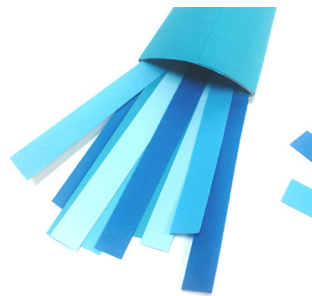
INSTRUCTIONS



1) Wrap the 4 1/2" x 6" cardstock around the empty toilet paper roll. Tape the cardstock down to the roll.

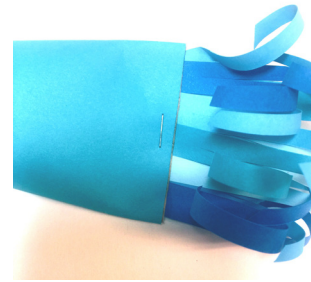


2) Pinch one end of the tube closed.

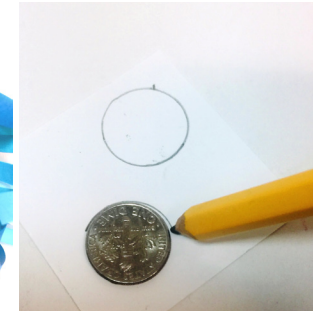


3) Cut strips of paper 1/2" wide and 4" - 4 1/2" long. Tape the strips between the pinched tube area, layering them to make it full.

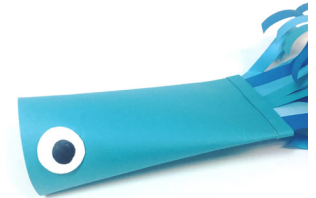
INSTRUCTIONS (Continued)



4) Tape the pinched area closed. Use a stapler if you need to but cover the staple with a strip of paper if you do. Cut the strips in half and curl the ends of each strip to make the tail.



5) Use a 1/2" circle punch or take a dime and trace two circles on the white cardstock. Cut out. Color in the eye with the black marker.



6) Glue an eye on either side of the open end of the tube.



7) Starting about two thirds away from the opening, create the fish scales all the way down to the tail. You can make the fish scales by either drawing them on with crayons/markers or cutting scraps of paper into circles and taping them on.



8. After the fish is decorated, make a tiny hole with the needle on opposite sides of the open end. String the crochet thread through the holes going from the outside to inside of the tube. Knot the thread ends on the inside of the tube to create the hanger.

Fill the fish with treats!
