Grad Cap Netting Favor

MATERIALS:

Dimensions for Small Favor:

- 1 2" X 5-1/2" Strip of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 2" X 2" Square of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 6" X 6" Square of White Tulle

Dimensions for Large Favor / Centerpiece:

- 1 4" X 11" Strip of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 5" X 5" Square of Cardstock (Any color)
- 2 6" X 12" Strips of White Tulle

Graduation Embellishments – Stickers, Die cuts, Rub-ons, etc.

SUPPLIES:

1/4" Double Stick Tape (DST)

Scissors

12" Paper Trimmer

1/4" Hole Punch (for Small Favor)

1/4" Anywhere Hole Punch Set (for Large Favor)

1 - Wire or Twist Tie

Optional:

Circle Punch (Small = 2" or Large = 3" size punch)
Twist Ties or Satin Ribbon

DIRECTIONS:

- Punch a hole in the middle of the Square Cardstock, using the 1/4" hole punch. Set that aside.
- On the Strip of Cardstock place the DST along the edge of only one short side and one long side. (*Tip:* If you plan to decorate the strip, do so before going on. You can write anything or place a photo.)
- 3. **Optional:** Use only half of the circle of the Circle Punches to make scallop like points along edge of strip.
- 4. Using the scissors, cut slits about every 1/2" along the long taped side of the strip. Use the width of the tape as your cutting guide, to show where to stop. You should have 1/4" wide flaps every 1/2".

Grad Cap Netting Favor

MATERIALS:

Dimensions for Small Favor:

- 1 2" X 5-1/2" Strip of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 2" X 2" Square of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 6" X 6" Square of White Tulle

Dimensions for Large Favor / Centerpiece:

- 1 4" X 11" Strip of Cardstock (Any color)
- 1 5" X 5" Square of Cardstock (Any color)
- 2 6" X 12" Strips of White Tulle

Graduation Embellishments – Stickers, Die cuts, Rub-ons , etc.

SUPPLIES:

1/4" Double Stick Tape (DST)

Scissors

12" Paper Trimmer

1/4" Hole Punch (for Small Favor)

1/4" Anywhere Hole Punch Set (for Large Favor)

1 - Wire or Twist Tie

Optional:

Circle Punch (Small = 2" or Large = 3" size punch)
Twist Ties or Satin Ribbon

DIRECTIONS:

DIRECTIONS, CONT.

- Remove all the wax backing from DST along the short & long side of strip and join the short end with the other short end to make a cylindrical tube.
- 6. Then fold the 1/2" flaps down, to the inside of tube with adhesive facing up.
- Place hole punched square cardstock onto table and place tube, tape facing down, centered onto the square. Use the punched hole to center the tube. Don't forget to press flaps down onto square.
- Place treats inside of the square tulle and gather all ends. Use the wire or twist tie to
 poke the tulle's ends through the 1/4" hole in square top of the cap. Pull ends
 through and take off wire.
- Optional: You can use colored Twist ties or a satin ribbon for an extra secure tie around the tulle.

DIRECTIONS, CONT.

- 5. Remove all the wax backing from DST along the short & long side of strip and join the short end with the other short end to make a cylindrical tube.
- 6. Then fold the 1/2" flaps down, to the inside of tube with adhesive facing up.
- 7. Place hole punched square cardstock onto table and place tube, tape facing down, centered onto the square. Use the punched hole to center the tube. Don't forget to press flaps down onto square.
- Place treats inside of the square tulle and gather all ends. Use the wire or twist tie to
 poke the tulle's ends through the 1/4" hole in square top of the cap. Pull ends
 through and take off wire.
- Optional: You can use colored Twist ties or a satin ribbon for an extra secure tie around the tulle.
