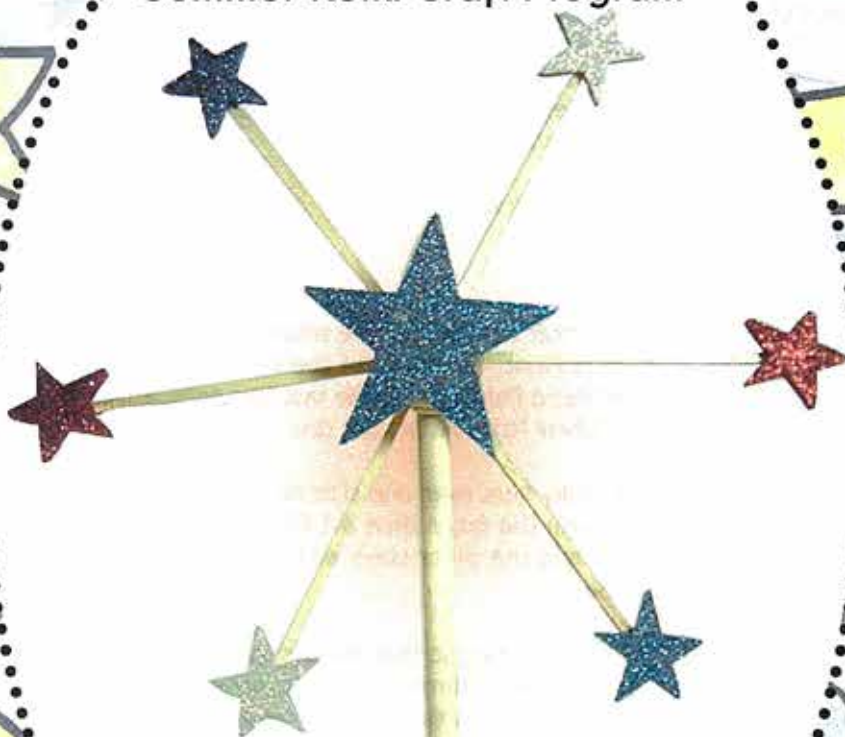

# Patriotic Pinwheel

## Supplies:

- 2 - 1" Wooden toy Wheel #7761 3109
- 2 1/4" Wooden pointed Star #7761 1798
- 6 - 1 3/16" wooden Pointed Stars #7793 8563
- Wooden Hat Rack Peg #7761 5047
- 5/16" x 12" Wooden Dowel #7718 7559
- 6 - Craft Picks #7767 6445
- Patio Paint - Sterling Silver #3000 0039
- Patio Paint - Geranium Red #3000 0011
- Patio Paint - Hydrangea Blue #3000 0037
- Art Glitter Opaque Royal Blue #7732 1935
- Art Glitter Opaque True Red #7732 1836
- Art Glitter Transparent Crystal #7732 2255
- Tacky Glue #7760 9875
- Low Temp Glue gun & Glue sticks
- Floral Wire Cutter



## Directions:

Paint the 2 1/4" wooden star and two of the smaller wooden stars with the Hydrangea Blue Patio Paint. Paint two of the smaller wooden stars with the Geranium Red Patio Paint. Paint the last two smaller wooden stars with the Sterling Silver Patio Paint. Let dry.

Spread a thin layer of Tacky glue over one side of each of the stars. Sprinkle the blue stars with the Royal Blue Art Glitter, the red stars with the True Red Art Glitter and the silver stars with the Crystal Art Glitter. Set all of the stars aside.

Using a wire cutter, cut the hat peg so that the peg measures about 1 1/2". Put one of the wooden toy wheels through the peg. Arrange the craft picks onto the other wooden toy wheel so that they are spaced out evenly (refer to fig. A), then glue the picks down. Put the wooden toy wheel with the picks onto the hat peg and glue both of the wheels together so that the craft picks are sandwiched in between the wheels. Glue a small star to the tip of each pick, alternating the colors. Glue the large Blue star to the middle of the front toy wheel.

Glue the end of the peg to the top of the wooden dowel so that it sits perpendicular on top of the dowel. Before gluing, make sure the dowel isn't too close to the wooden wheel. Otherwise, the pinwheel won't spin.
