Deco Mesh Wreath



Supplies:

Work wreath in color of choice (sample uses green, 30114830) 21"x10yd. Deco Mesh in color of choice (sample uses moss lime, 30121893) 4" Ribbon Foil in color of choice (sample uses red, 30115871) Scissors

Optional:

Christmas picks or ornaments Floral wire

Directions:

Starting with the top ring on the work wreath, open up a pair of pine boughs. Grab a hank of the Deco Mesh, scrunch it together, and place it in between the two pine pieces. Then, twist-tie the deco mesh into the wreath using the pine pieces to secure. Measure out 6 to 12 inches of deco mesh, scrunch, and secure in between the next two pieces of pine.

Continue placing bunches of Deco Mesh into the pine boughs all the way around the top ring of the wreath.

When you're done with the top ring, continue on to the bottom ring and add deco mesh the same way. When you're done with the first color (21 inch mesh), cut the remaining roll off of the wreath. Add the second (4 inch) ribbon to the wreath by opening the pine boughs and re-twisting the pine pieces with the ribbon in place.

If you want, you can also add other embellishments like floral picks or Christmas ornaments by wiring them onto the metal base of the wreath.
