Cardstocks; Tan, black, red and white

12" - 3/8" width ribbon of your choice

1 ea. – Screw eyes (for hanger) 30160259



Meriken double-stick tape 30013283

Circle cutter 30141341

Paper punch round size 1/2" 30136620 and 3/4" 30136621 or 30028718

Sharpie marker fine tip black (to draw mouth)

Low temp glue gun 77536417 & glue sticks 77533638

Sharp scissors 3013330

INSTRUCTIONS

- Use the circle cutter to cut out one 4-1/2" circle from the tan cardstock.
- Use the paper punch to punch out two 3/4" from white and two 1/2" from black cardstock.
- Trace and cut out two ears from brown felt and one nose from red cardstock.
- Use the double-stick tape to glue the tan circle cardstock to the wood slice surface, glue on eyes and nose. Draw the mouth below the nose.
- 5. Screw on the screw eye to the top of the wood slice.
- Cut the brown chenille stem in half, wrap the chenille stems around the sharpie pen to form spiral.
- Glue the ears behind the head and the spiral chenille stems in place. Refer to the picture above for placement.
- 8. Make a bow from ribbon, glue to the top of the head.
